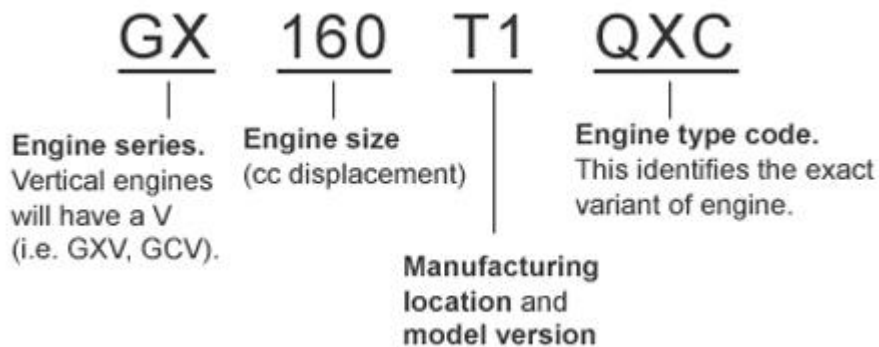

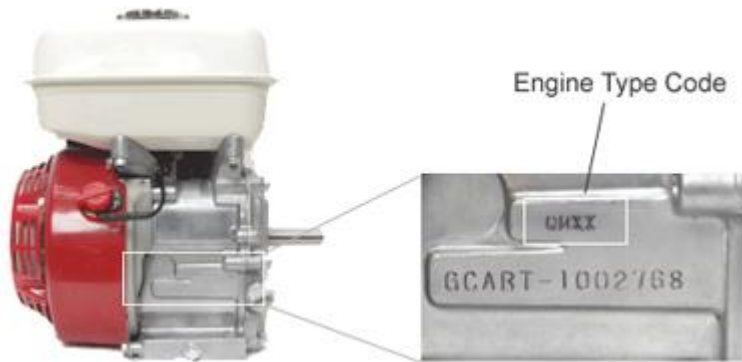
Honda Engine Model Naming System

Honda Engines use a standard model naming system to identify the **engine series**, **engine size** (cc displacement), **manufacturing location**, and the **engine type code**.



Engine Model Number

The model number of a Honda engine is printed on a sticker located on the engine cover or recoil assembly housing. All Honda engines model numbers start with "G", such as "G100", "GX610", or "GXV160". For some engines, you may also need to locate the serial number, which is normally stamped on the side of the engine.



Engine Type Code

The engine type code is stamped on the side of the engine near the serial number. The code consists of 4 characters, sometimes as asteriks (eg. QX** is a QX type engine)



Engine Serial Number

The serial number of a Honda engine is also stamped on the side of the engine. They have a 4 or 5 letter prefix, followed by a 7 digit number (eg. GCASK - 1005447).
